A TIME OF DEVELOPMENT

Our tennis program is unlike any program in the country. We have designed our program to prepare our players to have a successful college or professional career. We approach junior tennis training and competition as a time for **DEVELOPMENT, not results**. Any focus on results may slow or potentially damage that development. We have developed a comprehensive tennis, conditioning, mental toughness and tournament program designed to challenge each player to maximize his or her development, and to take them to the next level.

You don't have to be a national or international champion to train at Weil. We take players at all levels that have the motivation and fire to improve their mental and physical games.

CAMP INFORMATION

Level of Players: Weil accommodates many different levels of players. On the court, players are grouped by age and ability. Players will have a chance to train and compete against stronger players consistently throughout the week.

Training: Weil coaches stress mental toughness with a challenging daily training program and a comprehensive fitness program. The student to coach ratio is 5:1.

- Weil's ***Fitness Program*** focuses on intense sand and sprint work, medicine balls, coordination & balance drills combined with extensive flexibility work to increase our players' core strength and balance.
- ***Sprint & Distance Running*** – this routine is designed to give players a more explosive burst to the ball.
- We ***Cross Train*** with different disciplines, such as basketball, soccer, swimming, and volleyball to broaden our players' athletic abilities.

Coaching Staff: Weil employs full-time, certified, high-performance coaches from Japan, Morocco, Bulgaria, Serbia, Indonesia, France, Egypt, Ivory Coast, U.S., Sri Lanka, Slovakia, Czech Republic and Hungary.

Check-In: Boarding Players: Sundays between 12 – 1:30 pm. at the Boy's Dorm, adjacent to the Main Clubhouse, located at 428 Bryant Circle. Non-Boarding Players: Sundays at 1:50pm at the Ojai Valley Athletic Club located at 409 Fox St.. Training will begin promptly at 2:00pm and continue until 6pm (BBQ dinner will follow at the Girl's Dorm).

Check-Out: All Players: Fridays between 3:30-4pm. All players must sign out with the Residential Staff.

World-Class Training Facility: Weil Tennis Academy is located adjacent to and has full access to the Ojai Valley Athletic Club (a 10-acre, world-class, tennis training facility). The Club has fourteen tennis courts (ten hard courts and four HardTru). The Academy also uses sixteen courts at Libbey Park and Thacher School. The Club also boasts two full gyms, a lap pool, a recreational pool, two Jacuzzis, aerobics studio, a lightened hard-court basketball court, a beach volleyball court, and a grill.

Tournament Travel: What sets the Weil Tennis Training camps apart from other training camps is that Weil travels to tournaments at the end of most camp weeks. If you would like your child to participate in a tournament while they are here, there will be a \$250.00 charge for entry fees and travel expenses. In order to participate in USTA sanctioned tournaments, the camper must have a USTA Membership number. You may purchase one at:

Private Lessons: Private lessons are available with our full-time Head Tennis coaches, Assistant Tennis coaches, Fitness Director and Fitness Assistant. Please refer to our “2010 Private Lesson Fees” page for pricing information.

Video Analysis: Video Analysis is available to players who request it for a fee of \$150.00.

Summer HEAT!!!: (for summer camps only) Dry summer temperatures averaging 85° still give way to cool nights averaging 60°. However, in the event a player gets overheated, they will be cooled off in the pool, or made to sit in the shade and drink water. (All courts have drinking fountains available on site.)

Boarding Facilities: **Boarding is limited to 60 spots** and are supervised **at all times**. Each residential hall is equipped with a refrigerator and microwave for student use, laundry facilities, telephone stations, internet and a comfortable TV/DVD lounge. All campers have a roommate and every room comes with beds, desks, closets, dressers and a direct connection to the internet for each boarder.

Boarding Activities: After tennis the dorm parents and counselors organize activities for the players such as use of the pool, ping-pong, free-time for rest, board game night, etc. The dorm parents will organize evening off-campus 2 nights out of 5. For example: movies, Santa Barbara State Street shopping, Camarillo Premium Outlet shopping, beach in Ventura, bowling, Golf ‘n Stuff.

Weil also believes in exposing its players to college and professional level tennis matches. Players may travel with the Academy to these matches for a fee of \$35.00/day.

If your child plans to stay at the Academy through the weekend, there is the possibility that the Academy will travel to a So Cal amusement park (Disneyland, Magic Mountain, Universal Studios, etc.). The fee for weekend stay (Friday night through Sunday morning) is \$150.00. The academy will provide transportation and supervision, but tickets and meals are to be paid by each player.

Dining: The dining hall for the players is located on the main floor of the girl’s residential hall. Our personal chef and residential staff prepare lunch and dinner for the players Monday thru Friday (dinner on Sunday is provided). Breakfast foods (bagels & cream cheese, cereal & milk, yogurt, etc.) are available to players in each dorm hall. Our menus are designed to provide nutritious and balanced meals. A sandwich bar, salad bar and fruit bar are available at every meal. **Please advise if there are any special dietary needs for your child.**

Emergencies: In the event of extreme emergencies the Ojai Valley Hospital is just two minutes away. In the event of illness, Weil has a family practitioner available, Dr. Gilmore. Medical Forms are kept in the office in case we need to take your child for treatment.
